Whether it's a charity benefit, corporate outing, fundraiser, or a reunion of golf buddies, our staff can assist with all the details of the day.

The Pro Shop requests that a list of players (first and last names) with tee assignment next to each name be submitted no less than 4 days before your tournament. This will ensure that your tournament begins on time and runs efficiently.

Rangers will be on the golf course to oversee its use and to control play. Please respect and comply with any helpful hints, direction or friendly warnings the ranger may direct towards you and your group. Please keep in mind that rangers also have the authority to ask players to leave the course.

Shotgun Start

A shotgun start will require a minimum of 100 players and are not permitted on Wednesdays, Saturdays or Sundays before 1:00pm. To ensure that your tournament will start on time, Bear Creek asks the convenor to ensure that their players arrive 45 minutes before their scheduled shotgun time. Players should be in their carts 15 minutes before departure to their respective holes.

The tee is reserved from 7:00-8:00am on Saturdays, Sundays and holidays for Bear Creek members

DRESS CODE & PLAYING RULES



The dress code is designed to make everyone feel comfortable.

This dress code policy applies equally to all members, guests of members, green fee players and tournament players.

- ◆ Golf attire is recommended for all golfers.
- ◆ Collared shirts including regular, mock or crew neck collars, are acceptable.
- ◆ Sweaters including turtleneck, mock turtleneck, crew neck or V-neck sweaters are acceptable
- ◆ Tailored pants or dress shorts are acceptable.
- ◆ No clothing with offensive phrases or graphics will be allowed.
- ◆ Muscle shirts, tank-tops, tube-tops or halter-tops are not permitted.
- ◆ Track pants, gym shorts, cut-off shorts, beachwear, tear-away pants, rugby pants, jogging pants or shorts, cycling shorts, or spandex shorts or pants are not permitted.
- ◆ Bear Creek Golf & Country Club is a Soft Spike Only facility. Accordingly metal golf spikes are not permitted.
- ◆ Proper soft spike golf shoes or golf sandals, running shoes or soft flat soled footwear are acceptable.
- ◆ Baseball, soccer or any other shoes that have cleats are not permitted.

GOLFERS NOT CONFORMING TO THIS DRESS CODE WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO PLAY.

GOLF CARTS

- ◆ Convenor is required to provide credit card information in the event of damage to any golf carts.
- ◆ Golf carts shall be signed for before play and limited to 2 passengers and 2 golf bags.
- ◆ Golf carts shall be driven and used responsibly and with due care at all times.
- ◆ Golf carts are used at the player's own risk, and any damage must be reported immediately to the Pro Shop. Any repairs to cart or course property will be billed to the convenors' credit card.
- ◆ Golf carts must be driven and parked at least 15 feet away from greens and designated paths beside tees.
- ◆ Golf carts are not to be driven by any person under 18 years of age.
- ◆ Please drive in the rough as much as possible. Please report any irregularities in the cart's operation to Pro Shop staff.

ALCOHOL

It is against the liquor laws for any one to bring any alcoholic beverages onto the course property. All alcohol must be purchased and consumed in the Golfview at the Halfway Hut or from our Beverage Cart.

The Pro Shop staff may ask players to reveal the contents of their golf bags prior to entering the course. Any alcohol found in a player's golf bag will be removed.

RAIN OUT

All Tournaments will be held through rain or shine. The Pro Shop supervisor may postpone or cancel tournaments only due to lightning or if the course is deemed unplayable. If a tournament is cancelled at the discretion of Bear Creek, if a meal has been arranged, this will proceed as planned and convenor will be given a rain check for each player for the golf portion of the day.

MISCELLANEOUS

- ◆ For shotgun tournaments, to ensure that your tournament will start on time, Bear Creek asks convenor to ensure that their players arrive 45 minutes before their scheduled shotgun time. Players should be in their carts 15 minutes before departure to their respective holes.
- ◆ The tournament organizer must arrive and report to the Pro Shop a minimum of 1 hour before the scheduled tournament start time.
- ◆ All play shall begin at the First Tee (other than with permission from Pro Shop)
- ◆ 18 hole rounds are expected to be completed in 4 hours and 15 minutes or less.
- ◆ The golf club is not responsible for golf clubs and/or personal belongings left on the property or in lockers.
- ◆ Players are responsible for their own insurance coverage.
- ◆ Each player must have his/her own set of clubs in a bag or carrying device

GRATUITIES, TAXES AND POLICIES

Prices listed are subject to change without notice.

All food and beverage items must be supplied by Bear Creek Golf & Country Club. Donated food and/or beverage are not permitted to be brought onto the premises. Bear Creek will be the sole supplier of food and beverage. Any special items must have the club's approval. (Handling fee will apply)

Guarantee / Payment

A guaranteed number of guests must be submitted not less than 7 days prior to event. A list of players (first and last names) with tee assignment next to each name must be submitted to the Pro Shop no less than 4 days before your tournament. Only minor changes to the function agreement will be permitted after that time. All billings will be based on that guaranteed number or actual attendance, whichever is the greater number. All prices are subject to 13% HST and 15% gratuity on food and 10% gratuity on alcohol. Final payment of invoice is due 10 days after date of event.

Cancellations

If cancellation occurs less than 7 days before event, a cancellation fee will apply unless arrangements are made to re-book on another date. Any events cancelled within 7 days of scheduled event, the convenor will also be billed for costs incurred for any food / beverage purchased for event.

Display / Decorating Items

Banners or display items may not be affixed to any stationery wall, floor or ceiling with nails, staples or tape unless approved by the club. Any damage that is incurred by using the aforementioned items will be charged to the invoice.

Any outside display items that are brought in for your tournament must be removed from the premises immediately following. Bear Creek will not assume any responsibility for lost or damaged items left on the premises and items not removed will be subject to an additional room rental fee.

Property Damage

Convenor is responsible for any damage, above and beyond normal wear, to the building or grounds by guests or attendees.

Security

The Club shall not assume responsibility for the damage or loss of any merchandise or articles brought to the Club. The Club will not be responsible for items left unattended in the function room.

Bear Creek Golf Club is a semi-private club and we ask that the members be respected.
